- School of enrollment
- Grade level
- Resident district number/type
- Special education evaluation status (from one of 1, 2, 3, 5 or 8 to a 4 or 6, or from a 4 or 6 to a 7)
- Percent enrolled
- Homebound flag
- Federal instructional setting
