- For the past dozen years, only 3% of our overall budget has been spent on administration.

- 80% of the community approves of the school district's financial management. (Only 10% considered it below average.)

The district is one of fewer than 5% of Minnesota school districts recognized for Excellence in Financial Reporting from the Association of School Business Officials International

- 71% of the community gives the Spring Lake Park Schools a grade of A or B. (This is over one-and-one-half times greater than the national figure of 45%.)

- An overwhelming majority of the community agrees that promises made in the school district's 2006 bond referendum campaign are being kept. (Only 1.5% could identify a specific promise they believed was not yet kept.)

- 64% of the community supports renewal of an existing levy in the fall of 2009. (59% would support renewal –and an increase— if technology and the teaching of reading, math, and science were enhanced.)
