**Critical Criteria:**

- Did not take or verbalize body substance isolation precautions prior to interaction with patient.
- Did not determine scene safety.
- Did not provide high concentration oxygen at appropriate time.
- Did not evaluate and find conditions of airway, breathing, and circulation.
- Did not find, or manage, problems associated with airway, breathing, hemorrhage or hypoperfusion.
- Did not ask questions about the present illness.
